DESCRIPTION

The Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) are submitting tariff pages to introduce Contract Tariff Option 19 (Option 19) in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 and Contract Tariff Option 21 (Option 21) in Tariff F.C.C. No. 11. These offerings are exclusively for customers subscribing to a minimum of fifteen (15) new IntelliLight Entrance Facility (IEF) systems, IEF systems that were previously established under Contract Tariff Option 16 in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 or Contract Tariff Option 17 in Tariff F.C.C. No. 11, or any combination of the above. Each of these IEF systems must be configured to include a Fractional OC48 Interface and twelve (12) or more STS1 terminations. The serving areas for these contract tariffs are the Phase I and Phase II Telephone Company Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) of both Tariffs F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 11.

These contract tariff options are filed pursuant to Verizon receiving Pricing Flexibility relief for Special Access Services in qualifying MSAs¹.

These new Contract Tariff Options are specifically designed for new installations of eligible Verizon Special Access IEF services which are ordered during the first sixty (60) days following the effective date of the instant filing (i.e., the subscription period). With this contract option, discounted monthly rates will apply for each IEF STS1 termination in accordance with the terms and conditions specified in the attached tariff pages.

Additionally, these Contract Tariff Options include special allowances for IEF services under these contract options that experience chronic service interruptions. Also included are terms and conditions relating to the application of termination liability under various

circumstances, as more fully described in the contract tariff. Except as otherwise provided in the attached tariff pages for these Contract Tariff Options, liabilities, penalties, and general terms and conditions as they pertain to IEF Services in other sections of the tariffs also apply to IEF Services under these contract tariff option.

The attached tariff pages provide a complete description of the terms and conditions and rates and charges that apply under these new Contract Tariff Options.
