With this transmittal, Verizon is proposing the following:

- (1) Introduction of a new Customer Network Management Optional Feature for IntelliLight® Dedicated SONET Ring (IDSR) service. Direct Transaction Language 1 (TL1) Monitoring Optional Feature (DTM) will provide a customer with near real-time information about the operational status of its IDSR service.

- (2) Revisions to Customer Service Management Optional Feature (CSM), an existing Customer Network Management Optional Feature for IDSR service. These revisions include:
- Clarification of the service description for CSM
 - Clarification of the application of rates and charges
 - Modification of regulations in order to allow reconfiguration of circuits that either connects locations where an IDSR node is located on the IDSR ring or connects a location that is on the IDSR ring to a location that is off the IDSR ring
 - Modification of regulations that will allow the customer to establish coterminous expiration dates for its CSM and its IDSR service upon expiration of its initial CSM term plan

The clarifications made in this filing do not affect the rates, terms, or conditions under which the customer initially subscribed to CSM.

Support material as specified under Section 61.49 of the Commissions Rules is not required with this filing. However, a document describing the proposals included in this transmittal is attached. In addition, Figure 1 is attached which identifies the price cap basket and service category into which the new Customer Network Management Optional Feature will be incorporated. Figure 1 will be used in the 2005 Annual Filing to demonstrate that this service should be granted the same Phase I or Phase II regulatory relief in the MSAs and non-MSAs where the service category has been granted such relief.

Payment in the amount of \$720.00 has been electronically transmitted to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically via ETFS.
