**PURPOSE**

Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) proposes to increase the DS1 High Capacity Portability Commitment Level to 90%.

**DESCRIPTION**

Under the current DS1 High Capacity Service Portability Commitment, customers are required to maintain a minimum commitment level of at least 80% under a 2, 3, 5, or 7 year DS1 TPP each month.

Effective with this filing, the 80% portability commitment level will no longer be available to new customers, this will be grandfathered for existing customers. There will be no change to existing DS1 portability commitment customers. In addition, NBTC proposes to introduce a 90% commitment level in which customers are required to maintain under a 2, 3, 5, or 7 year DS1 TPP each month.

**PRICE CAP COMPLIANCE**

The proposed change meets the definition of a restructure as outlined in Part 61.3(II) of the Commission's Rules. During the current base period, all customers met their portability commitment levels, therefore no charges were incurred. In accordance with 61.46(c), 61.47(d), and 61.49(e), a Tariff Review Plan (TRP) is attached. The IND-1 of the TRP demonstrates that the Actual Price Index (API) remains below the Price Cap Index (PCI) and all Service Band Indexes (SBIs) are below the associated SBI Upper Limits.
