Under authority of Special Permission No. 05-002 of the Federal Communications Commission, Verizon is submitting tariff pages that introduce a new Contract Tariff Option (Option) in its Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 11. Verizon has received Pricing Flexibility relief for Special Access Services in qualifying Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) of those tariffs. This Option provides a customer who subscribes to Broadcast Video Service with billing credits when the customer meets a monthly service commitment for each of the twelve months of the service period for this Option and other requirements as set forth in this Option.
