Application is hereby made by Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) for Special Permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw without becoming effective Transmittal No. 84.

On December 13, 2004, in Transmittal No. 84, NBTC made a filing in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, proposing changes to the terms and conditions governing the collection of security. Transmittal No. 84 was scheduled to become effective on December 28, 2004.

On December 27, 2004, the Federal Communications Commission issued Order DA 04-4048 suspending Transmittal No. 84 for five (5) months and initiated an investigation. NBTC filed a Reply to the petition to suspend Transmittal No. 84 on December 23, 2004. NBTC also submitted a Supplement No. 5 filing reflecting the suspension on January 3, 2005, pursuant to Order DA 04-4048.

With this filing, NBTC wishes to restore currently effective material and to withdraw without becoming effective material filed under Transmittal No. 84 in order to review issues identified in the proposed modifications. Also, NBTC is canceling Supplement No. 5 and issuing Supplement No. 6 in order to revise the effective date in the tariff pages in Transmittal No. 84. Illustrative tariff pages are attached for your review.

A waiver of Section 61.58 is requested to permit the revision of tariff material to become effective on not less than 1 day's notice. A waiver of Section 61.59 is requested to permit revisions to tariff material that is not yet in effect.

This Application letter and the appropriate illustrative tariff pages are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).

Payment in the amount of \$720.00 has been electronically transmitted to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically via ETFS as a proprietary document. These actions have been committed on the date established as the issued (filed) date as reflected above.
