This filing is being made on 15 days' notice under the Federal Communications Commission's streamlined filing procedures, and proposes the following revisions to Tariff F.C.C. No. 3:

- (1) Addition of clarifying tariff language for entrance facility, channel termination and ATM access termination rate elements to state that rates for these elements will apply even if the customer designated premises and the serving wire center are collocated in the same Telephone Company building;
- (2) Within band, within cap rate adjustments for special access services provided in all of Sprint LTC's jurisdictions;

- (3) Rate adjustments to special access services in all metropolitan statistical areas (MSAs) where pricing flexibility has been granted in accordance with Subpart H of Part 69 of the Commission's rules;
- (4) Clarification of existing regulations for Sprint LTC's expanded interconnection services and introduction of a Co-Carrier Cross Connect (CCXC) direct cabling rate element; and
- (5) Removal of expanded interconnection electrical cross connect rates in the state of New Jersey where Sprint LTC currently has no customer demand.


Cost support material in accordance with Sections 61.38 and 61.41 through 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is provided, where required, for this filing.
