With this filing CBT proposes to make textual changes, clarifications and typographical corrections to Section 7 – Special Access. The proposed changes are predominantly in the OC-3, OC-12, OC-48, and OC-192 Point-to-Point and Dedicated Services Sections. These proposed changes do not affect rates. CBT also proposes to grandfather the OC-3 Point-to-Point Channel Termination (OC-3 Drops) rate element and the OC-12 Point-to-Point Channel Termination (OC-12 Drops) rate element.
