DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION

With this filing, NBTC proposes revisions to existing verbiage for clarification purposes and to correct inadvertent errors in various sections of the tariff. In addition, NBTC proposes to delete specialized service arrangements which have expired, and are no longer applicable.

- Modify the Table of Contents to include the True IP to PSTN (TIPToP) Service, which was inadvertently omitted.
- Section 7: Change section reference 5.X.X.X on page 7-91.1, to the correct section reference of 7.13.13.
- Sections 8 and 22: Modify the Multi-service Optical Network (MON) Ring Service channel mileage Universal Service Order Code (USOC) IYAZX, to the correct USOC of 1YAZX.
- Section 13: Revise the premium time language for additional labor to include President's Day, a Telephone Company observed holiday, which was inadvertently omitted. There will be no change to existing customers or their services.
- Section 13: Modify the stand by language for additional labor to clarify that Telephone Company personnel will stand by at the customer's request. There will be no change to existing customers or their services.
- Section 13: Modify the maintenance of service language for additional labor to clarify that Telephone Company personnel does not need to be at the customer premise to verify trouble. There will be no change to existing customers or their services.

- Section 24: Revise the TIPToP table of contents subsection numbers and page numbers on page 24-1.

In addition to the above revisions, NBTC proposes to delete specialized service arrangements which have expired, and are no longer applicable. There will be no customer impact.
