With this filing, Ameritech is proposing to increase the Dial Station, Initial Minute and Additional Minute Rate periods in Section 3 of Tariff FCC No. 4, Interstate IntraLATA Message Telecommunications Services. The proposed rate changes do not affect price cap indices. Section 61.58(d)(2) of the Commission's Rules state that a local exchange carrier (LEC) that has removed its Interstate IntraLata toll services from its Interexchange basket shall file subsequent tariff filings on one day's notice and Section 61.49(f)(4) allows for submission of such filings without cost support. Customers have been notified via a bill page message in the billing period February 7, 2005, through March 4, 2005.

In accordance with Section 61.14, this transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS) in compliance with the electronic filing procedures.
