On April 11, 2005, the Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) filed Application No. 140 requesting a waiver of Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules. Verizon then submitted a first amendment to Application No. 140 on April 15, 2005. Verizon is now submitting a second amendment to Application No. 140 in order to submit revisions to two of the illustrative tariff pages that were submitted for Tariff No. 1 under the first amended Application and one of the illustrative tariff pages that were submitted for Tariff No. 11 under the first amendment of Application No. 140.

Verizon intends to introduce a new Contract Tariff Option in its Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 11, Access Services. The new Contract Tariff Option provides a customer with billing credits when the customer meets certain total billed revenue (TBR) thresholds for qualifying services. In order to calculate TBR and administer other provisions of these Contract Tariff Options across the operating territories of Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 11, Contract Tariff Option 25 filed in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 must reference Contract Tariff Option 27 in Tariff F.C.C. No. 11 and the Contract Tariff Option 27 filed in Tariff F.C.C. No. 11 must reference Contract Tariff Option 25 in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1.

In addition, Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 11 must each make reference to each other in order to determine the service area and qualifying services of the new Contract Tariff Options.

Illustrative tariff pages are included with this application.
