DESCRIPTION

The Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) are submitting tariff pages in order to grandfather two services - INFOPATH Packet Switching Services (INFOPATH) in its Tariff F.C.C. No. 11 and Public Data Network (PDN) in its Tariff F.C.C. No 1. Verizon is grandfathering these services because the equipment used to provide and maintain the services has been discontinued by the manufacturer. Verizon offers several alternatives (such as Digital Data Service, Frame Relay Service, and Asynchronous Transfer Mode Cell Relay Service) for customers who wish to migrate from INFOPATH or PDN. As of the effective date of the tariff, additions, moves, or changes to INFOPATH or PDN will not be permitted. All existing customers have been notified of this change in service by notification letter. Complete details of the change in service are shown in the attached revised tariff pages.
