Special Promotion for BellSouth Alternate DA Service Capability

DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION

TRANSMITTAL NO. 902

INTRODUCTION

With this filing, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "BellSouth") is revising its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Section 9 to introduce a special promotion for BellSouth Alternate DA Service Capability (ADASC). Transmittal No. 902 is being filed on May 17, 2005 to become effective June 1, 2005.

DESCRIPTION OF AND JUSTIFICATION FOR THE PROMOTION

During the promotion period beginning June 1, 2005 and continuing through November 30, 2005, nonrecurring charges described in 9.5.3 (A) and (B) will not apply to new orders for BellSouth Alternate DA Service Capability (ADASC). The customer will, however, be billed and obligated to pay these nonrecurring charges if the service ordered is terminated prior to being in service for six (6) months.

Competitive offers of wholesale DA do not require up-front expenditures by prospective customers to accommodate interconnection requirements. BellSouth offers this promotion to make its BellSouth ADASC competitive in the market and more attractive to prospective customers.

PRICE CAPS INDICES

The BellSouth ADASC special promotion filing applies to incremental demand only and does not impact existing demand. For this reason, this promotion does not create any price cap headroom or effect price cap indices in any manner. In addition, the Tariff Review Plan for the BellSouth ADASC special promotion filing reflects the pending expiration of BellSouth's DSL Promotion #2. Workpapers SUM-A and SP-1 display price cap indices and rate detail for this filing demonstrating that BellSouth remains within all allowable limits.
