RE: May 2nd Shortform TRP Letter Filing

The Verizon Telephone Companies<sup>1</sup> will be filing a revision to the 2005 Annual Price Cap Filing in compliance with Section 61.43 of the Commission's rules. As required by Section 61.49(k), attached is a revised 2005 Tariff Review Plan (TRP) to reflect the demand adjustment pursuant to receiving Phase II Pricing Flexibility relief for End-User Channel Termination Special Access Services in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA)<sup>2</sup> for the purpose of early review. This filing is also necessary as a result of the tariff and demand modifications submitted under Transmittal No. 581.

This filing is submitted in the format prescribed in the 2005 Tariff Review Plan Order.<sup>3</sup>

This filing provides the revised 2005 Shortform TRP for GTTX to reflect the removal of demand in the revenues and indices. All support documentation is provided as an attachment with this Letter.
