Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Beehive Telephone Companies: Beehive Telephone Company, Inc. and Beehive Telephone Co. Inc. Nevada ("Beehive"), application is being made pursuant to Section 61.151 of the Federal Communications Commission's Rules and Regulations ("Rules") for special permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Rules.

Beehive requests permission to withdraw, on not less than one-day's notice, the revised Interstate Access Service Rate for Tandem Switching filed under Transmittal No. 26 on June 24, 2005 of its Access Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 without them becoming effective.

This request is necessary because: (1) the Tandem Switching Rate was incorrect due to an inadvertent clerical error; (2) the Description and Justification was inadvertently omitted; and (3) Transmittal No. 26 should have been shown as Transmittal No. 27.

Upon receipt of the Special Permission requested herein, Beehive will re-file only the revised page of its tariff with the correct Tandem Switching Rate. Beehive will also file its Description and Justification.

Pursuant to Section 61.153(b) of the Rules, the original of this Application, Form 159, and a check for \$720.00 have been sent by courier to the Mellon Bank, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Pursuant to Section 61.153(c) of the Rules, and in addition to the filing today of this package with the Commission's Secretary,


