With this transmittal, Verizon submits tariff pages to introduce Optical Hubbing Service (OHS). This service provides a dedicated high capacity optical facility from a customer designated location to a Verizon optical hub and offers an alternative to basic Entrance Facility and Channel Termination configurations. Also under this transmittal, Verizon is introducing several additional Optical Hubs for OHS in Tariff F.C.C. No. 11. In addition, Verizon is removing the 7-Year OC48 or OC48c Optical Hubbing Interface rate element in its Tariff F.C.C. No. 11. This rate element was inadvertently included when OHS was originally introduced under Transmittal No. 492 on September 22, 2004, even though the terms and conditions for OHS state clearly that OC48 or 48c Optical Hubbing Interface is only available under 3-Year and 5-Year commitment periods.

Supporting material as described under Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is not required with this filing. However, a document describing OHS in detail is attached. In addition, Figure 1 is attached, which will be used in the 2006 Annual Filing to demonstrate that OHS should be granted the same Phase I or Phase II regulatory relief in the MSAs and the non-MSAs where the service category has been granted such relief.

Payment in the amount of \$720.00 has been electronically transmitted to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically via ETFS.
