The accompanying tariff material, issued by the Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) and bearing Tariff F.C.C. The Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) are submitting tariff pages to introduce a contract tariff option for customers who subscribe to new IntelliLight Dedicated SONET Ring Service (IDSR) at Optical Capacity 48 (OC48) or Optical Capacity 192 (OC192), who upgrade an existing OC48 IDSR to a new OC192 IDSR, or who convert OC48 IDSR or OC192 IDSR from certain other contract tariff options in accordance with the new contract tariff option . This new option is being filed in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 and Tariff F.C.C. No. 11 where Verizon has received Pricing Flexibility relief for Special Access Services in qualifying Metropolitan Statistical Areas. With this option, eligible customers who subscribe to this contract tariff option will receive discounted monthly rates for the IDSR node, mileage and certain port rate elements as described in the attached tariff pages.

Supporting material as specified under Sections 61.49 of the Commissions Rules is not required with this filing. A description of the new contract tariff option is attached to this filing.

Payment in the amount of \$720.00 has been electronically transmitted to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically via ETFS.
