Application is hereby made by the Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) for Special Permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59(c) of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw Transmittal No. 107.

On July 29, 2005, NBTC issued Transmittal No. 107, Contract Offer No. 4, which required the concurrent subscription to Ameritech Telephone Companies (Ameritech) Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, Section 22, Contract Offer No. 73; Pacific Bell Telephone Company (PBTC) Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Section 33, Contract Offer No. 65; Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT), F.C.C. No. 73, Section 41, Contract Offer No. 54; and The Southern New England Telephone Company (SNET) Tariff F.C.C. No. 39, Section 25, Contract Offer No. 18 (erroneously filed on July 29, 2005 as Contract Offer No. 17).

NBTC Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Section 23, Contract Offer No. 4, Transmittal No. 107 became effective on August 2, 2005.

With this Application, NBTC requests permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59(c) of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw, on not less than one day's notice, the tariff material filed under Transmittal No. 107 which is currently in effect but has not been in effect for more than 30 days.

When submitting the tariff filings on July 29, 2005, SBC Communications Inc. (SBC) encountered extreme internet congestion while making the NBTC and the other related tariff filings. Consequently, the tariffed Contract Offers filed by PBTC and NBTC were not filed by the 7:00PM Eastern Time deadline thus leaving two of them with incorrect Issued and Effective Dates. Since each Contract Offer requires the customer to simultaneously subscribe to the identical contract in each of SBC's currently effective tariffs, NBTC wishes to withdraw the tariff material filed under Transmittal No. 107 in order to refile it so that it becomes effective concurrently with the other associated tariffed Contract Offers.

This Application letter and the appropriate illustrative tariff pages are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).

Payment in the amount of \$720.00 has been electronically transmitted to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically via ETFS as a proprietary document. These actions have been committed on the date established as the issued (filed) date as reflected above.
