With this filing, NBTC is proposing to introduce DecaMAN to NBTC's Access Service Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. DecaMAN is a fiber based, point-to-point, 10 Gigabit Ethernet service that allows customers to transport data signals between local area networks (LANs). DecaMAN transports data signals at the rate of 10 Gigabits per second (Gbps). The DecaMAN product provides a native Ethernet interface with two options: LAN-PHY and WAN-PHY.

Supporting information discussed under Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules, to the extent applicable, is included with this filing in the attached Description and Justification.
