

**NEVADA BELL TELEPHONE COMPANY
DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION
TRANSMITTAL NO. 111
September 19, 2005**

With this filing, Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) proposes to introduce language to the True IP to PSTN (TIPToP) Service tariff that will expand the descriptions of the one-way and two-way port interfaces, clarify the requirements needed prior to ordering service, separate the LNP queries associated with TIPToP Service, and reduce the month to month rates for TIPToP one-way and two-way port interfaces.

The proposed changes are as follows:

- Section 5 – Clarify the requirements needed before ordering TIPToP service and clarify what charges apply when changes to any order to update LRNs occurs. Changes that update LRNs on TIPToP orders will incur existing applicable access order modification charges detailed in the existing tariff.
- Section 24 - Expand the description of the one-way and two way port elements to denote the applicable service components received when ordering TIPToP Service, and to indicate that LNP queries are not included and must be obtained under other sections of the tariff.
- Section 24 – Clarify the LNP query elements received and applicable charges for these services for customers who order TIPToP service. The Telephone Company will provide Service Provider Number Portability (SPNP) query service to the TIPToP customers under the existing rates and terms for SPNP query service in Section 19.
- Section 24 – Reduce month to month rates for TIPToP one-way and two-way port interfaces.

PRICE CAP COMPLIANCE

Supporting information discussed under Section 61.38 of the Commission's Rules is, to the extent applicable, included with this filing. Some of this information is filed with a request that it be treated as confidential under the Freedom of Information Act. NBTC is requesting that the supporting information be placed under the Protective Order designated under CC docket No. 96-187, Report and Order F.C.C. 97-32, released January 31, 1997 (Streamlining Order), and the Order on Review released October 14, 1997, in the matter of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company Tariff F.C.C. No. 73, Transmittal Nos. 2646, 2647, 2649 and 2656.
