Application is hereby made by Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) for Special Permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw currently effective material filed in Transmittal No. 110 on not less than one day's notice.

On September 14, 2005, in Transmittal No. 110, NBTC introduced DecaMAN as a new service to its Access Service Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. DecaMAN is a fiber based, point-to-point, 10 Gigabit Ethernet service that provides customers with the capability of transporting data signals between Local Area Networks (LANs). Additionally, NBTC inappropriately introduced Price Flex rates for the DecaMAN Service. Transmittal No. 1505 became effective on September 15, 2005. With this application, NBTC wishes to discontinue the effective Price Flex rates associated with the DecaMAN service.

A waiver of Section 61.58 is requested to permit the revision of tariff material to become effective on not less than one day's notice. A waiver of Section 61.59 is requested to permit revisions to tariff material that has not been in effect for 30 days.

This Application letter and the appropriate illustrative tariff pages are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS). Payment in the amount of \$720.00 has been electronically transmitted to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically via ETFS as a proprietary document. These actions have been committed on the date established as the issued (filed) date as reflected above.
