On September 14, 2005, in Transmittal No. 110, NBTC introduced DecaMAN as a new service to its Access Service Tariff F.C.C. No.1. DecaMAN is a fiber based, point-to-point, 10 Gigabit Ethernet service that provides customers with the capability of transporting data signals between Local Area Networks (LANs). Additionally, NBTC inappropriately introduced Price Flex rates for the DecaMAN Service. Transmittal No. 110 became effective on September 15, 2005.

With this filing, NBTC wishes to withdraw currently effective material filed under Transmittal No. 110 in order to discontinue the Price Flex rates for the DecaMAN Service. Transmittal No. 110 became effective on September 15, 2005.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
