Application is hereby made on behalf of Qwest Corporation (Qwest) FRN 0003-7467-57 (Concurring Carriers, The Malheur Home Telephone Company FRN 0003-7467-65 and El Paso County Telephone Company FRN 0004-3212-46), for Special Permission to waive the requirements of Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's rules.

Qwest intends to make a filing to change tariff material associated with Transmittal No. 252, which was filed September 23, 2005 and has an effective date of October 8, 2005. Qwest seeks permission to change language associated with customers ordering DSL via www.Qwest.com to allow its business partners that operate online to also offer the same terms as those offered to those customers using www.Qwest.com. Since these on-line partners also realize the same economies as Qwest does when customer order on-line, their customers should also realize comparable savings.

A waiver of Section 61.58 of the Commission's rules is requested to allow Qwest to change tariff material on not less than one day's notice. In addition, a waiver of Section 61.59 of the Commission's rules is requested to allow Qwest to change tariff material that has not been in effect for 30 days. The requested effective date of this change will be October 21, 2005.

The Application filing fee in the amount of \$720.00 is being paid by credit card through the appropriate entries in Section E of the ETFS generated Form 159.
