OC192c Internet Protocol (IP) Port**

DESCRIPTION

An IP Port enables customers to aggregate traffic from IP-VPN services and other data services from Verizon's IP network to a Service Provider's network. Currently, IP Ports are available in capacities of OC12c and OC48c. This filing will add OC192c capacity to the available options for IP Ports. Customers must also purchase OC12c, OC48c or OC192c SONET services from appropriate Verizon tariff(s) as an access facility from their POP to the IP Port.

A monthly recurring charge applies per IP Port based upon the capacity ordered by the Customer. A minimum of one pair of IP Ports must be ordered per LATA to satisfy Company configuration requirements for managing load balance and diversity.
