This filing is being made on 15 days' notice under the Federal Communications Commission's streamlined filing procedures, and in compliance with the requirements of the Commission's decisions in CC Docket No. 02-53.<sup>1</sup> Sprint LTC proposes to revise the current presubscribed interexchange carrier (PIC) change charge structure to include one rate for changes that are processed electronically and a separate rate for PIC changes that are processed manually. The safe harbor charge for changes in a customer's PIC submitted electronically is \$1.25 and the charge for processing a PIC change manually is \$5.50. Sprint LTC will adopt these new safe harbor rates. In addition, rates are being added to the tariff that are equal to 50% of the full PIC change charge when a customer requests a PIC change in conjunction with their intraLATA PIC.


