Concord Telephone Company is an issuing carrier billing end user charges under JSI Tariff FCC No. 1 but who bills traffic sensitive, special access and miscellaneous charges including PIC Change Charges under National Exchange Carrier (NECA) Tariff FCC No. 5.


In order to comply with the Commission's *PIC Change Charge Order*, this filing divides the existing nonrecurring charge for an InterLATA PIC change into four separate nonrecurring charges, which will apply based on whether the change request is submitted to the Telephone Company using manual or electronic methods and whether the request is for InterLATA only or also includes an IntraLATA PIC Change request.

Cost support is not provided with the filing as the rates fall within the safe harbor levels established by the Commission in the PIC Change Charge Order.
