The Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) are submitting tariff pages to introduce a contract tariff option for customers who convert an existing Special Access IntelliLight® Dedicated SONET Ring (**existing IDSR**) to a new Special Access IntelliLight® Dedicated SONET Ring (**new IDSR**) in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Option. This new option is being filed in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 and Tariff F.C.C. No. 11 where Verizon has received Pricing Flexibility relief for Special Access Services in qualifying Metropolitan Statistical Areas. With this option, eligible customers who subscribe to this contract tariff option will receive discounted monthly rates for the IDSR node and mileage rate elements as described in the attached tariff pages.

Supporting material as specified under Sections 61.49 of the Commissions Rules is not required with this filing. A description of the new contract tariff option is attached to this filing.
