Application is hereby made on behalf of Qwest Corporation (Qwest) FRN 0003-7467-57 (Concurring Carriers, The Malheur Home Telephone Company FRN 0003-7467-65 and El Paso County Telephone Company FRN 0004-3212-46), for Special Permission to waive the requirements of Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's rules.

Qwest intends to make a filing to change tariff material associated with Transmittal No. 254, which was filed October 17, 2005 and has an effective date of November 1, 2005. Qwest seeks permission to change the start and end dates associated with the QWEST DSL Market Trial due to technical problems with implementing a next day due date. Once FCC Special Permission is granted a revised reseller notification will be sent out advising customers of the new effective dates.

A waiver of Section 61.58 of the Commission's rules is requested to allow Qwest to change tariff material on not less than one day's notice. In addition, a waiver of Section 61.59 of the Commission's rules is requested to allow Qwest to change tariff material that has not been in effect for 30 days. The requested effective date of this change will be November 1, 2005.

The Application filing fee in the amount of \$720.00 is being paid by credit card through the appropriate entries in Section E of the ETFS generated Form 159.
