This Application for Special Permission requests a waiver of Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw the material filed under Transmittal No. 154.

Transmittal No. 154, filed November 2, 2005, established, on one day's notice, LNP Query Service for KentuckyAlltel. Based upon discussions with the Commission staff, Alltel has decided to withdraw Transmittal 154 which was filed with an improper notification period and refile the information on 15 day's notice with required cost support.

A waiver of Section 61.58 is necessary to make changes to material on not less than one day's notice. A waiver of Section 61.59 is necessary in order to delete tariff material that has not been in effect for 30 days.
