With this filing, CBT is changing its Interstate IntraLATA Directory Assistance rates on one day's notice pursuant to the Commission's Fifth Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, Released August 27, 1999 (Pricing Flexibility Order). In the Pricing Flexibility Order, the Commission allows Price Cap LEC's to file Interstate IntraLATA rate changes on one day's notice after these services have been removed from Price Cap Regulation. CBT filed a letter with the Commission to remove its Interstate IntraLATA services from Price Cap regulation effective November 6, 1999.

The required filing fee, in the amount of \$720.00, an original copy of this letter, and FCC Form 159 were sent to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, PA, via Federal Express on November 10, 2005, as required.
