1. With this filing, Verizon is revising its Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 11 to distinguish that certain IntelliLight® Broadband Transport Service arrangements are now provided under standard intervals.

2. On August 26, 2005, under Transmittal No. 614, Verizon filed revisions to make DSL available when a Customer's end user receives local exchange service from a carrier that uses Verizon's loop and switching facilities, other than a reseller of Verizon's local exchange service, provided that such carrier has agreed to make the high frequency portion of this loop available to Verizon at no charge. With this filing, Verizon is removing the regulation in Tariff F.C.C. No. 20 restricting the availability of this option to certain states.
