This filing is being made on 15 days' notice under the Federal Communications Commission's streamlined filing procedures, and proposes to add rates and regulations introducing LATA-Wide Unlimited Interstate as an optional calling plan available to individual residential and business customers who originate direct distance dialing long distance (1+) calls within the Telephone Company's exchanges and have selected the Telephone Company as their primary intraLATA long distance carrier. In addition, this filing includes various textual changes which correct or clarify the provision of interstate intraLATA MTS service.


