Qwest is filing tariff language in its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Section 8, Advanced Communications Networks, to introduce a promotion for Metro Optical Ethernet (MOE). Under the terms of this promotion, first time MOE customers may subscribe to a three month term in lieu of the existing MOE requirement that all initial orders must be for a minimum of twelve months. Customers will pay the existing Non Recurring Charges and Monthly Recurring Charges during the term of the promotion.

The promotion offering will allow potential MOE customers to test the service from an ordering, provisioning and ethernet backbone interoperability standpoint. Qwest estimates that this promotion will result in 12 circuits being ordered with associated revenue of \$70,080. The promotion is scheduled to run from December 15, 2005 through March 14, 2006.

The Tariff filing fee in the amount of \$720.00 is being paid by credit card through the appropriate entries in Section E of the ETFS generated Form 159.
