1. With this filing, Verizon is providing clarification of its existing Commitment Discount Plan minimum period regulations in Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 11.

2. With this filing, Verizon is providing revisions to its Internet Protocol – Virtual Private Network (IP-VPN) service offering in Section 5.12, Part I of Tariff F.C.C. No. 20 to expand the availability of service to include Delaware LATA 228 and Maryland LATA 236. Also included in this filing, Verizon is introducing two Virginia CLLIs where Internet Protocol (IP) Ports will be offered for National Transparent LAN Service and IP-VPN service.
