This filing is made pursuant to the Commission's *Report And Order*, In the Matter of Presubscribed Interexchange Carrier Charges, FCC 05-32, released February 17, 2005.

With this filing CBT proposes to:

1. Bifurcate its PIC Change charge into mechanized change and manual change charges.
2. Increase the manual PIC Change charge from \$5.00 to the \$5.50 Safe Harbor.
3. Decrease the mechanized PIC Change charge from \$5.00 to \$1.25
4. Establish a rate of one-half of the interstate PIC Change charge when interstate and intrastate PIC changes are made simultaneously.

The original letter, completed FCC Form 159, and a check for \$720.00 to pay the required filing fee were sent to Mellon Bank, Pittsburgh, PA via Federal Express on December 15, 2005.
