The Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) hereby apply for Special Permission for a waiver of Section 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules.

On December 12, 2005, Verizon filed Transmittal No. 653 to introduce a new contract tariff option for customers who order Special Access IntelliLight[®] Broadband Transport Service or multiplexed Special Access IntelliLight[®] Broadband Transport Service in accordance with the requirements set forth in the option. The new contract tariff option was filed as Option 33 in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 and Option 36 in Tariff F.C.C. No. 11. Transmittal No. 653 is scheduled to become effective December 27, 2005.

Upon subsequent review of the material filed under Transmittal No. 653, Verizon found that it inadvertently filed the Option 33 rates as the rates contained in Option 36 and the Option 36 rates as the rates contained in Option 33. As a result, Verizon requests special permission to waive the requirements of Section 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw the material pending under Transmittal No. 653 prior to its scheduled effective date of December 27, 2005.
