Application is hereby made on behalf of Qwest Corporation (Qwest) FRN 0003-7467-57 (Concurring Carriers, The Malheur Home Telephone Company FRN 0003-7467-65 and El Paso County Telephone Company FRN 0004-3212-46), for Special Permission to waive the requirements of Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's rules.

Qwest intends to make a filing to change tariff material associated with Transmittal No. 261, which was filed December 16, 2005 and has an effective date of December 31, 2005. Qwest seeks permission to remove two definitions and clarify other tariff language associated with Interexchange Carrier Subscription. These changes are being made at the request of the Commission staff.

A waiver of Section 61.58 of the Commission's rules is requested to allow Qwest to change tariff material on not less than one day's notice. In addition, a waiver of Section 61.59 of the Commission's rules is requested to allow Qwest to change tariff material that has not been in effect for 30 days. Qwest understands that these changes will not have deemed lawful status. The requested effective date of this change will be December 31, 2005.
