Issuing carriers for JSI Tariff FCC No. 1 are listed on Attachment A to this transmittal letter along with the respective FRN number for each carrier and JSI.

JSI makes this filing on behalf of the Comporium Communications Companies, Rock Hill Telephone Company, Lancaster Telephone Company and Fort Mill Telephone Company ("Comporium Companies"). Each of the Comporium Companies is individually an issuing carrier for JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1.

This filing cancels the Asymmetric Digital Subscriber Line (ADSL) offerings of the Comporium Companies effective January 11, 2006 under the Wireline Broadband Order.¹

On December 12, 2005, JSI provided on behalf of the Comporium Companies notice to the Commission of the Comporium Companies' intent to cancel provision of ADSL on a tariffed basis effective January 11, 2006. A copy of the notice is being provided with this filing.

The filing includes modifications to both rate pages and regulations. With respect to rate pages, the ADSL rate page for each of the three Comporium Companies is revised to reflect discontinuance of ADSL service. With respect to regulations, this filing modifies regulations in Sections 7 and 16 related to the interconnection of WBI transmission services offered by the Telephone Company on a non-tariffed basis with Metallic Access Service, High Capacity Access Service, Synchronous Optical Channel Service and synchronous Transfer Mode Cell Relay Service provided under the tariff. In addition, the filing also expands the description of the DSL Access Service Connection Point in Section 16.2, ADSL to specify that the DSL Access Service Connection Point may be used to interconnect DSL Access Services provided under the tariff or WBI transmission services provided on non-tariffed basis with the specified tariffed, interstate access services.

No other issuing carriers for JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 are affected by this filing.

With respect to customers, the only customers for the Companies' ADSL Services are the nonregulated operations of the respective Company. The 30-day notice to the nonregulated operations of each Company was provided by interoffice memorandum cover for the notice document provided to the Commission.

Any cost impacts associated with this filing will be reflected in the annual access charge filing, with respect to Special Access and in NECA pool settlements with respect to Common Line. The Companies bill Switched Access and Traffic Sensitive Rates under JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 pursuant to Section 61.38 and bill Common Line pursuant to National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA) Tariff F.C.C. No. 5.

Pursuant to Section 61.32(b) of the Commission's Rules, the original of this letter, Form 159, and a check for \$720.00 have been sent via overnight delivery to the Mellon Bank, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, as of this date.
