Waiver of Termination Liability Charges for
Disconnecting Transport of Only non-EUA DSL Connection

DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION

INTRODUCTION

With this filing, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "BellSouth") is revising its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Section 28 to waive Termination Liability Charges (TLCs) for disconnection prior to fulfilling the customer-specified commitment period of facilities utilized in the transport of only BellSouth ADSL service Connection not associated with End-User Aggregation (EUA).

Transmittal No. 950 is being filed on January 17, 2006 to become effective February 1, 2006.

JUSTIFICATION FOR TARIFF MODIFICATION

BellSouth no longer offers PVC based DSL (DSL not associated with EUA) arrangements. BellSouth is making this change to waive TLCs for transport of existing PVC based DSL to provide NSPs additional flexibility in transitioning their service arrangements.
