# Supplemental Notice of Discontinuance of Common Carrier Broadband Internet Access Transmission Service

CC Docket No. 02-33

On December 8, 2005, the Comporium Companies filed 30-day notice with the Federal Communications Commission (Commission) regarding their intention to discontinue provision of Wireline Broadband Internet Access Service (“WBIAS”) on a common-carriage tariffed basis pursuant to the Commission’s *Wireline Broadband Order*.<sup>1</sup> This supplement modifies the timeline for detariffing and indicates that upon detariffing the Comporium Companies will offer WBIAS on a **detariffed common-carriage basis** pursuant to paragraph 94 of the *Wireline Broadband Order*.

The Comporium Companies (“Companies”) comprise the following three affiliates all of which operate exclusively within South Carolina and each of which is an individual issuing carrier for John Staurulakis, Inc. Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 (“JSI Tariff FCC No. 1”):

The Companies currently provide wireline broadband Internet access service (WBIAS) through Asymmetrical Digital Subscriber Line (“ADSL”) Service described in Section 16.2 of JSI Tariff FCC No. 1. These regulations mirror those in National Exchange Carrier Association Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 (“NECA Tariff FCC No. 5”) for ADSL Access Service. NECA regulations for ADSL Access Service are at Section 8.1 of NECA Tariff FCC No. 5.

## **Impact on Customers**

The only customer for the Companies’ ADSL Service is the nonregulated operations of the respective Companies. The nonregulated operations of each of the Companies purchases the ADSL Service for use as a component in its broadband Internet service sold to consumers and business customers. The cancellation of the tariffed ADSL service will have no effect on the end user service provided by Comporium.

The Company will continue to make WBIAS available on a common-carriage basis through posting of rates, terms and conditions on its Internet web-site in a manner similar to that required for interstate and international interexchange services under Section 42.10 of the FCC's rules (47 C.F.R. § 42.10). The initial rates will be those offered under tariff. Any change in rates, terms and conditions will be made on fifteen-day advance notice to customers and shall apply to both the affiliates and non-affiliates on a non-discriminatory basis. Cost allocations related to WBIAS will continue to be handled as under the status quo.
