**AT&T Petitions for Pricing Flexibility for Dedicated Transport and Special Access Services -WCB/Pricing No. 06-08, Petition of Ameritech Operating Companies, WCB/Pricing No. 06-09, Petition of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 69.729 of the Commission's rules, AT&T therein demonstrates that two services introduced in 2005, DecaMAN<sup>SM</sup> and WaveMAN<sup>SM</sup> would be properly incorporated into the high capacity special access and DDS services category within the special access price cap basket.

DecaMAN<sup>SM</sup> and WaveMAN<sup>SM</sup> are variations of GigaMAN<sup>®</sup> and SONET services, respectively, which have been granted pricing flexibility and incorporated into the high capacity special access and DDS services category within the special access price cap basket. DecaMAN<sup>SM</sup> is a fiber-based, point-to-point, Ethernet service that allows customers to transport data signals between local area networks (LANs). DecaMAN<sup>SM</sup> is functionally equivalent to GigaMAN<sup>®</sup>, but transports data signals at the rate of 10 Gigabits per second (Gbps), a speed ten times faster than that of GigaMAN<sup>®</sup>. WaveMAN<sup>SM</sup> is similar to AT&T's existing Optical Carrier Network Point-to-Point services. WaveMAN<sup>SM</sup> is a fiber-based, point-to-point, Wavelength service that allows customers to transport Synchronous Optical Network (SONET) Optical Carrier (OC) 48 or SONET OC192 data signals between networks at approximately 2.5 Gbps for an OC48 interface, and approximately 10 Gbps for an OC192 interface.

To date, there has been no demand for DecaMAN<sup>SM</sup> or WaveMAN<sup>SM</sup>. Thus, these services do not impact Appendix C of AT&T's Petitions for Pricing Flexibility or AT&T's satisfaction of the pricing flexibility triggers set forth in Section 69.711 of the Commission's rules.
