On behalf of Beehive Telephone Companies: Beehive Telephone Company, Inc. and Beehive Telephone Co. Inc. Nevada ("Beehive"), application is being made pursuant to Section 61.151 of the Federal Communications Commission's Rules and Regulations ("Rules") for special permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Rules.

Beehive requests permission to withdraw, on not less than one-day's notice, the revised tariff filing made under Transmittal No. 31 on February 14, 2006 of its Access Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 without the revisions becoming effective.

This request is necessary because of uncertainty regarding the applicability of the NECA Tariff.

Upon receipt of the Special Permission requested herein, Beehive will file to withdraw the new rate and reset its tariff as it was prior to the February 14, 2006 filing.

Pursuant to Section 61.153(b) of the Rules, the original of this Application, Form 159, and a check for \$720.00 have been sent by courier to the Mellon Bank, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Pursuant to Section 61.153(c) of the Rules, and in addition to the filing today of this package with the Commission's Secretary, a copy of this Special Permission application also has been hand delivered to the Chief, Tariff and Price Analysis Branch and to the commercial contractor, Qualex, Inc.

Beehive submits that a grant of this request would minimize the burden upon it,
