This filing is being made on one day's notice and proposes to remove the word "Sprint" from the names of three existing service offerings in anticipation of the proposed legal separation, which must be approved by several state regulatory commissions, of the Sprint LTCs from Sprint Nextel. Sprint Sense Local Toll Service will be known as Consumer Sense Local Toll Service; Sprint Business Sense Local Toll Service will be known as Business Sense Local Toll Service; and Sprint Simply FiveSM will be known as Simply Five. In addition, reference to a Sprint Global Access Calling Card has been changed to Global Access Calling Card. The rates and regulations associated with the three services remain unchanged. The changes made in this filing are textual only to reflect the name change of these services.

Cost support material in accordance with Sections 61.38 and 61.41 through 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is not required for this filing.


