This filing proposes revisions on behalf of the following issuing carriers for JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1:

Farmers Telephone Cooperative, Inc. SAC 240520 (SC)
Interstate Telephone Company SAC 220371 (GA)
Pineland Telephone Cooperative, Inc. SAC 220377 (GA)
Warwick Valley Telephone Company SACs 160135 (NJ), 150135 (NY)

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For Pineland Telephone Cooperative, Inc. (Pineland) and Farmers Telephone Cooperative, Inc. (Farmers), this filing cancels the respective Asymmetrical Digital Subscriber Line (“ADSL”) Access Service offerings of each carrier pursuant to paragraph 94 of the Commission’s Wireline Broadband Order.¹ Concomitant with the cancellation of the respective ADSL offerings of Pineland and Farmers, this filing also proposes on behalf of the companies removal of each company’s respective Special Access High Capacity DSL Access Connections. Additionally, this filing proposes cancellation of Pineland’s related Asynchronous Transfer Mode-Cell Relay Service (ATM-CRS) Optional Features for DSL Access Connections.

As indicated in the respective permissive detariffing notices filed with the Commission through the FCC Electronic Comment Filing System (ECFS) in CC Docket 02-33 on March 1, 2006, Pineland and Farmers will offer wireline broadband Internet transport service on a permissive non-tariffed common carriage basis under Title II beginning April 1, 2006. A copy of each carrier’s 30-day notice is included with this filing. DSL access connections will also be offered on a common carriage basis under Title II.

In addition, revisions to the respective Pineland and Farmers rate pages to effect permissive detariffing of wireline broadband Internet access transport services, corresponding revisions to page 16-12 are proposed to remove Pineland and Farmers from the table at Section 16.2 indicating which issuing carriers offer ADSL Service. In addition to removing Pineland and Farmers from the table, the proposed revised sheet eliminates Coastal Utilities, Inc. from the table. Coastal Utilities, Inc. withdrew as an issuing carrier for JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 effective December 9, 2004, to become an issuing carrier for Madison River Telephone Company LLC (MRTC) Tariff F.C.C. No.1. JSI inadvertently failed to remove Coastal from the Section 16.2 table at that time.

For Interstate Telephone Company (Interstate) and Warwick Valley Telephone Company (Warwick) this filing proposes revisions to the Federal Universal Service Charge (FUSC) rates and/or factor effective April 1, 2006. Interstate and Warwick are the only issuing carriers for JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 who are not in the National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA) Common Line Pool. As non-members of the NECA Common Line Pool, Interstate and Warwick bill all end user charges including the FUSC under JSI Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. The proposed increases to the FUSC rates and/or factor are reflective of the proposed 10.9 percent Universal Service Fund Contribution Factor for the second quarter of 2006. See Federal-State Joint Board on Universal Service, CC Docket No. 96-45, Public Notice, DA 06-571 released March 13, 2006.

¹ See *Appropriate Framework for Broadband Access to the Internet over Wireline Facilities, Universal Service Obligations of Broadband Providers*, CC Docket No. 02-33, WC Docket No. 05-271, Report and Order and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, 20 FCC Rcd 14853 (2005), FCC 05-150 (Rel. Sept. 23, 2005), (*Wireline Broadband Order*).

Support for the Pineland and Farmers filings is limited to the 30-day permissive detariffing notices for each carrier. Warwick files specific rates for FUSC corresponding to individual end user charges. Pursuant to Section 61.38, cost support is being provided for the Warwick FUSC filing. Interstate's FUSC filing is limited to filing the FUSC factor and does not require rate development as does the Warwick FUSC filing.

Pursuant to Section 61.32(b) of the Commission's Rules, the original of this letter, Form 159, and a check for \$720.00 have been sent via overnight delivery to the Mellon Bank, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, as of this date.

Customers will be notified of the proposed changes in accordance with the Commission's requirements.
