**PURPOSE**

Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) proposes to introduce a new Messaging Application Service. Outbound Messaging Application will be introduced in Section 6 of Tariff F.C.C. No. 1.

**DESCRIPTION**

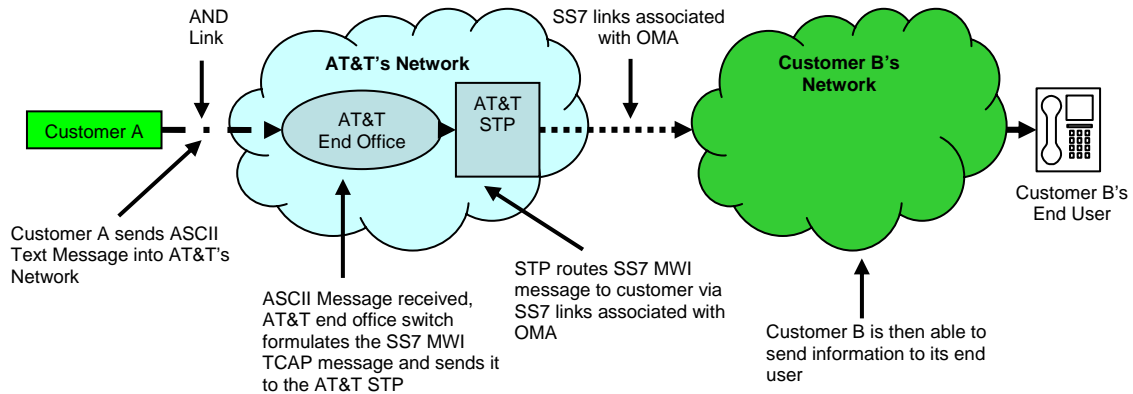
Outbound Messaging Application service sends a Message Waiting Indicator signal through the Telephone Company's SS7 Network to the Customer. The Outbound Messaging Application Customer is responsible for the delivery of signaling messages associated with Message Waiting from a Customer Designated Message Waiting Service (e.g., Voice Mail Provider) to the Telephone Company's SS7 Network.
