No. 14, Facilities for Interstate Access; and Tariff F.C.C. No. 20, Communications Service; is sent to you for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. Under authority of Special Permission No. 06-019 of the Federal Communications Commission, Verizon is introducing a new Contract Tariff Option in its Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 11, Access Service (FCC 1 and FCC 11); Tariff F.C.C. No. 14, Facilities for Interstate Access (FCC 14); and Tariff F.C.C. No. 20, Communications Service (FCC 20). The new Contract Tariff Option (Option) will provide billing credits for customers who subscribe to the new Option and maintain a minimum annual revenue commitment for qualifying services. The qualifying services for the new Option include SONET/optical services, Fast Packet services and Facilities Management Services (which is a service option for high capacity 1.544 Mbps (DS1) and 44.736 Mbps (DS3) Services). Since Verizon has not previously filed Contract Tariff Options that include Fast Packet services, Verizon is introducing a new section in FCC 20 that will contain the general regulations and Contract Tariff Options for those Metropolitan Statistical Areas where Verizon has been granted Phase I pricing flexibility relief for Fast Packet services. In addition, Verizon is revising its FCC 1, FCC 11, and FCC 14 to expand existing regulations for Contract Tariff Options to include Fast Packet services purchased under FCC 1 or FCC 20.

Supporting material under Section 61.49 is not required with this filing. However, a document with a detailed explanation of the filing is being provided as an attachment hereto.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS). Payment in the amount of \$720.00 has been electronically transmitted to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically over ETFS.
