With this filing, NBTC is proposing to clarify existing rules and regulations as they relate to the Shared Network Arrangement (SNA) feature. New language will be added to Section 5 (Ordering Options for Switched and Special Access Service) of F.C.C. No. 1. Existing SNA language found in the product specific sections of the tariff will be grandfathered, and customers will be referred back to the new SNA language in Section 5. The SNA Processing Charge will remain the same. New definitions, pertaining to SNA, will be added to the tariff. All of these proposed revisions will help to clarify and standardize the SNA language for all 13 states.

Supporting information discussed under Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules, to the extent applicable, is included with this filing in the attached Description and Justification.
