With this filing, Verizon is proposing the following revisions to Interstate IntraLATA Service, Business Generic Optional Calling Plans, Unlimited Local and Toll Usage for business:

- 1) In FCC No. 4, the month-to-month rate for the District of Columbia and Virginia will be changed.
- 2) In FCC No. 5, the month-to-month rate for Pennsylvania will be changed.
- 3) In FCC No. 12, the month-to-month per line rate for the jurisdiction of the tariff will be changed. Also as a cleanup item, the 1-year term commitment for New Jersey is being removed. New Jersey has no LATAs that cross state boundaries, so the filing of this rate for New Jersey is not required in the Message Telecommunications Service (MTS) tariff.
- 4) In FCC No. 15, the month-to-month rate for Virginia will be changed. The state of Texas will be added to both month-to-month and 1-year term commitment. However, Texas does not have customers currently utilizing this service, therefore there is no usage available to determine the appropriate rate for the service. The rate for the service will be adjusted as customers subscribe to the service. Also as a cleanup item, the List of LATAs and Rate Centers for Texas will be changed to reflect the current ownership of the exchanges.

Supporting material as described under Section 61.49 of Commission's Rules is not required with this filing.
