This filing is being made by Qwest in its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Section 10, Federal Government Specialized Service or Arrangements, to revise the Government Emergency Telecommunications Service (GETS). GETS provides assured communications for authorized Federal Government, State Government and Specified Non-Government users in support of National Security and Emergency Preparedness for the nation.

In this filing Qwest is increasing the HPC Change Charge to reflect enhancements requested by the customer. The new rate was calculated by taking 2.32 hours per switch times a labor rate of \$54.00 per hour ($2.32 \times \$54.00 = \125). A 25% mark-up was then applied to this amount to arrive at the new \$156.25 rate. Obsolete service language and rates were also deleted from the tariff.

Supporting information discussed under Sections 61.38 and 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is, to the extent required, included in this transmittal letter.

The Tariff filing fee in the amount of \$720.00 is being paid by credit card through the appropriate entries in Section E of the ETFS generated Form 159.
