In accordance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, Telephone Utilities Exchange Carrier Association ("TUECA") is filing herewith revisions to its Tariff F.C.C. No. 2, Access Services, to become effective on 15 days notice on July 1 as shown on the following checksheet:

This filing completely removes wholesale Digital Subscriber Line (DSL) service from the tariff by removing the rates and conditions associated with it. TUECA has elected to remove these rates from regulation.

As indicated in the respective permissive detariffing notices filed with the Commission through the FCC Electronic Comment Filing System (ECFS) in CC Docket 02-33 on June 1, 2006 TUECA will offer wireline broadband Internet transport service on a permissive non-tariffed common carriage basis under Title II beginning July 1, 2006. A copy of the 30-day notice is included with this filing. DSL access connections will continue be offered on a tariffed basis.

Effective July 1, 2006 TUECA will begin offering its broadband Internet access transmission services (normally referred to as Digital Subscriber Line or DSL service) on a de-tariffed basis. Please note that carriers choosing to offer Wireline broadband Internet access on a de-tariffed basis are required to continue to provide Wireline broadband Internet transmission service for one year on a grandfathered basis to all unaffiliated Internet Service Providers (ISPs). As such, the current rates, terms and conditions governing CenturyTel's DSL services offered to unaffiliated ISPs will remain in effect until November 15, 2006. Those current terms and conditions will be available at this website: www.centurytel.com effective July 1, 2006, and will also be available for review at CenturyTel's Corporate Office located at 100 CenturyTel Drive, Monroe, Louisiana.

While the de-tariffing of this service does not constitute a discontinuance of service, the FCC has asked carriers that implement de-tariffing to follow procedures similar to those required for discontinuance of service. Consistent with those requirements, we hereby inform you that CenturyTel's address is 100 CenturyTel Drive, Monroe, Louisiana. We also inform you that the geographic areas affected by this change are the areas served by the companies listed above where DSL is available.

Cost support is not required for this filing by Part 61.38 of the Commissions rules.
