Citizens Telecommunications Companies ("Citizens") submits herewith its Description and Justification ("D&J") in support of changes to its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 filed under Transmittal No. 168. In this Transmittal, Citizens revises tariff language dealing with customer audits of bills, provision of duplicate invoices, and End User Common Line (EUCL) terms and conditions.

Citizens' existing tariff language dealing with customer audits of access bills has led to some confusion as to what procedures will be followed when a customer wishes to audit the access billing process or examine a specific question. Citizens revises its tariff language dealing with this subject to provide better clarity and to be in keeping with the current capabilities of Citizens' billing systems. Similarly, Citizens changes its language dealing with duplicate invoices to reflect current industry practices with respect to billing and the capabilities of Citizens' billing systems.

Citizens revises the terms and conditions for End User Common Line
